<p>This is a primitive form of flow control.</p> <p>Currently, if the MDS is experiencing a backlog of RADOS operations, the clients may continue to send lots of metadata operations and proceed with their own data operations. If the data and metadata pools share OSDs, that can exacerbate the situation.</p> <p>To convince the clients to slow down a bit when the MDS is having trouble getting OSD operations completed, we should disable early replies to clients when there are any slow requests in the Objecter on the MDS.</p>
